Ride the Delaware and Ulster Railroad and Visit the Kingston Trolley Museum

The Electric Railroaders' Association, with co-sponsorship by the NY Railroad Enthusiasts, is pleased to announce our 2014 day trip to see the historic transportation institutions of the Catskills and Hudson Valley.

We will take a chartered bus from the NYC Port Authority and hop aboard the scenic Delaware and Ulster Railroad. Join us and unwind during a leisurely-paced excursion from Arkville, NY to Roxbury, NY and back, offering some of the country's most magnificent scenery. The gorgeous Catskill Mountains frame the tracks for much of the trip, creating a magnificent backdrop. In addition to the train, the two rail stations are historically accurate and architectural classics.

Lunch will be available at a variety of restaurants and diners in the downtown Kingston area, a few minutes from The Kingston Trolley Museum. After lunch concludes, we will head over, as a group, to view their subway and rapid transit displays. In addition, they have a 1 ½ mile track from downtown Kingston to picnic grounds on the shore of the Hudson River. After our ride on their trolley, we will head back to NYC.

Our chartered Coach Tours bus will leave promptly at 8:00 AM from the east side of 8th Avenue, just south of West 41st Street, across the street from the Port Authority Bus Terminal. It is expected that the bus will return before 7:30PM, so there will not be a dinner stop.
